The White Earth Reservation Tribal Council is currently seeking a qualified applicant who will be responsible for providing Children's Therapeutic Services and supports (CTSS), which consists of activities designed to promote skill development of both the child and the family of American Indians who reside at Dream Catcher Homes and Giqanakamiin. This position will require travel between both sites.

- Provides services to emotional disturbed (ED) and/or severely emotional disturbed (SED) children/adolescents and their families, including social skills training, leisure and recreational activities, parent education, and school consultation.
- Maintains all forms of documentation and reports to ensure records meet provider and third party billing requirements.
- Participates in individual and group supervision with MH Professional to ensure effectiveness of services and gain insight for treatment.
- Performs other duties and responsibilities as required or assigned.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Knowledge of the demographics, culture, customs and geography of the White Earth Reservation.
- Knowledge of tribal and county health and social services programs.
- Knowledge of federal laws including HIPPA, government regulations, federal privacy act and agency rules.
