- Provide guidance to all security guards.
- Maintain good rapport with staff, employees, and external sources including tribal, state, and federal representatives.
- Managing a security team assigned to a specific shift.
- Training personnel and recommending applicants for corrective action and additional training.
- Planning, organizing, directing, and scheduling shifts.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Knowledge of and ability to follow and apply the policies and procedures of the White Earth RBC and Public Safety Department.
- Knowledge of relevant equipment, policies, procedures, and strategies to promote effective local, state, or national security operations for the protection of people, data, property, and institutions.
