The Adult Mental Health Program Manager works to align program goals with organizational objectives and foster collaboration across divisions to provide holistic and accessible mental health services.

- Develop and implement the mental health program for adults that address a range of mental health issues, including anxiety, depression, and trauma.
- Listen to and respond to visitors, clients, and employee concerns.
- Collaborate with community partners to ensure the success and sustainability of the adult mental health program.
- Provide supervision and support to a team of mental health professionals, case management, and mental health peer support/family support to ensure
- high quality service delivery.
