This role is pivotal in aligning program activities with our mission and organizational objectives, fostering collaboration across various divisions to ensure comprehensive service delivery.

Position Outcomes:

- Responsible for the oversight and direction of administrative programming for the White Earth Mental Health Youth Program.
- Develop and implement the mental health program for youth that address a range of mental health issues, including anxiety, depression, and trauma.
- Listen to and respond to visitors, clients, and employee concerns.
- Collaborate with community partners to ensure the success and sustainability of the adult mental health program.
- Provide supervision and support to a team of mental health professionals, case management, and mental health peer support/family support to ensure high quality service delivery.
