WHEREAS,	the White Earth Reservation Business Committee provides financial support to Anishinabe Legal Services, a Minnesota legal non-profit, representing tribal members including White Earth tribal members in civil legal matters, and
WHEREAS,	the White Earth Reservation Business Committee employs Andrea Kingbird as General Counsel, and
WHEREAS,	Andrea Kingbird, prior to being retained by the White Earth Reservation Business Committee, has served on the Anishinabe Legal Services Board of Directors, now
<b>THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,</b> that the White Earth Reservation Business Committee hereby authorizes Andrea Kingbird to continue service on the Anishinabe Legal Services Board of Directors with the understanding Ms. Kingbird would abstain from any decision as a Board Member that conflicts with the interests of the White Earth Reservation Business Committee.
