- whereas, the White Earth Reservation Business Committee (WERBC) is the duly authorized governing body of the White Earth Band, and
- WHEREAS, the White Earth Reservation Business Committee has established the Natural Resources Department, which consists of: Conservation/Enforcement, Environmental Affairs, Water Resources, Cultural Resources/Archives, Forestry, Land Office, Zoning, Fisheries, Wildlife, Wild Rice, Agriculture, Parks, and Pesticides/Emergency Management, and
- WHEREAS, it is the intent of the WERBC to effectively, efficiently, and properly manage the natural resources of the White Earth Reservation, and
- whereas, the White Earth Reservation Business Committee desires to promote the protection and preservation of any bison resources that may be established at White earth through proper management for the use of its members and future generations, and
- whereas, the White Earth Reservation Business Committee agrees to accepts the onetime gift of \$250,000.00 from the Margaret A. Cargill Philanthropies to provide additional economic development opportunities through utilization of buffalo, and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the White Earth Reservation Business Committee hereby approves the acceptance of a one-time monetary gift of \$250,000.00 from the Margaret A. Cargill Philanthropies to assist in launching the bison project in White Earth Nation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the White Earth Reservation Business Committee hereby authorizes the Chairman, Secretary-Treasurer or Executive Director to enter into negotiations and to sign the application and all necessary contracts and documents pending legal review for the above-stated purpose.
